This Year's Summer Camp

This summer, our camp theme is the four Classical Elements which make up the world around us: Fire, Water, Air and Earth.

Students will have the chance to explore the natural world through a range of activities which stimulate the senses and appeal to all learning styles. Each week we will explore science and nature, arts and crafts, sensorial and movement activities, literacy and thinking games, and hands-on food preparation through the prism of each of the elements.

Students may enrol in morning or afternoon sessions, or attend both! Each session will be different, with no repeated content or activities. Activities are planned and led by our experienced teaching staff, and camp sessions are conducted in English.

Apart from the dynamic and hands-on learning activities, our summer program has the extra advantage of being held in a Montessori classroom, where students are able to choose from a wide range of activities and experience the student-directed experiential Montessori learning approach.

There are a total of 8 different sessions: each session is 2½ hours and runs 5 days a week. A daily snack and drink will be provided. A Summer Camp Certificate will be awarded upon successful completion.

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Terms of Enrolment

The enrolment and admission to summer camps offered by Island Children's Montessori is subject to the conditions outlined below. By signing this form, the parent has accepted these conditions and policies:

1. Campers must enrol in a minimum of 2 sessions.
2. This application will not be processed if payment is not received in full.
3. Tuition fees paid are not transferable to another program, child or sibling.
4. Requests to transfer to another session can be made only once and are subject to space availability.
5. The maximum applicable discount is determined by the postmark date, or if submitted in person, date received by ICMH office.
6. The maximum discount only applies when fees are paid in ONE transaction during the period of discount.
7. There are **NO** refunds, fee deductions, adjustments or withdrawal from program once this application is submitted, with the exception of class or course cancellation.
8. There are **NO** refunds, fee deductions, adjustments or withdrawal due to personal reasons including sickness or travel plans.
9. All classes at ICMH continue to operate under Tropical Cyclone Signal 1 or 3; yellow and red rainstorm warning advice.
10. Class cancellations that are beyond the control of ICMH, such as Tropical Cyclone Signal 8 or above, black rain storm warning advice, EDB advice, illness, or other unforeseen circumstances will not result in fee adjustments, refunds or makeup lessons.
